7. KEEP YOUR PERSONAL GEAR REMAINING ON THE SHIP LOCKED UP.
8. DO NOT LEAVE PILFERABLE GEAR UNATTENDED ON THE SHIP.
9. THE DUTY OFFICER AND DUTY CHIEF WILL INSPECT THE SHIP AT EACH CHANGE OF YARD SHIFT.
